

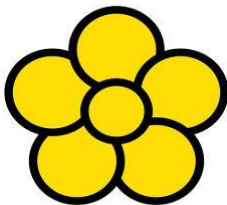

WHAT IS DYSLEXIA?

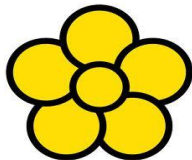
Dyslexia is a hidden disability and it is a specific learning difficulty, which affects a person's ability to learn and process information.

Symptoms of Dyslexia

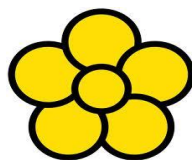
People that are diagnosed with Dyslexia may show some of these symptoms:



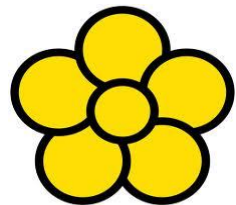
- Weakness with spelling
